


Total expenditure on health, % GDP






High performance in related quality-cost indicators



Life expectancy at birth and health spending per capita, 2005




Digital medical record in health centres and population covered. National Health System 2009








Development of electronic health records in Spain. SNS 2006/2009 97% EHR in Primary care 70% in Hospitals








